

SaskBarley Hosting Director Elections

October 15, 2015

A call for nominations to fill three director positions for the Saskatchewan Barley Development Commission (SaskBarley) has resulted in seven nominees, including two nominees seeking re-election.

The producer-elected board of directors ensures barley producers have the resources, leadership and representation to strengthen Saskatchewan's barley industry through research, market development and advisory activities. The SaskBarley board of directors is comprised of six registered barley producers who are elected for a four year term.

Election ballots must be received by the Returning Officer by December 2, 2015 at 4:00 pm. Successful candidates will officially begin their term immediately following the SaskBarley Annual General Meeting on January 11, 2016.

SaskBarley is a producer-elected and directed commission working to ensure barley is a long term, profitable and internationally competitive crop choice for Saskatchewan farmers. The first elected Board of Directors took office January 13, 2014.
